

MISSION AND VOCATION THE VOCATION OF SAINT BERNADETTE



Dates: All year round..



Duration: as requested by the group.



What?

- Teaching on vocation: How can Saint Bernadette help us choose our path in life?
- Testimonies of commitment to Christian life or life consecrated to God.
- Meeting a religious community close to the Sanctuary to serve/share/pray.

STAKING PART IN PRAYING THE ROSARY AT THE GROTTO



Dates: Every Wednesday, from April to August, a few children and/or young people from your group can take part in the rosary.
2.30 p.m.: preparation – location to be specified
3.00 p.m.: prayer of the rosary



Duration: 1 hour



What? Discover the prayer of the rosary, learn to pray like Bernadette. This prayer was a part of Bernadette's life, at each apparition and every evening with her family. It is a daily event for pilgrims at the Sanctuary

THE PROCESSIONS IN THE SANCTUARY



Dates: Every day from April to October, a few children and/or young people from your group can actively participate. The meeting time gives you time to prepare. The location is still to be confirmed.



Duration: 1½ to 2 hours



What? Create a unique memory of:

- **helping with the offertory procession during the international Mass (young girls). Every Wednesday and Sunday, meet at 8.30 a.m.**
- **serving during the international Mass (young boys). Every Wednesday and Sunday, meet at 8:30 a.m.**
- **serving during the Eucharistic procession. Every day, meet at 4.15 p.m.**
- **serving as statue bearers during the Marian procession. Every day, meet at 8 p.m.**
- **carrying candles during the Marian procession. Every day, meet at 8 p.m.**



LITTLE HOUSE OF BERNADETTE CHILDREN & FAMILIES AREA



Location: In the hemicycle (hall and small rooms upstairs), the 'Little House of Bernadette' welcomes children aged 0 to 12, accompanied by their families or their activity leaders and catechists.



What? The purpose of this space is to nurture in each child a desire to grow closer to God through the Virgin Mary, following the example of Saint Bernadette. A team of experienced activity leaders is on hand to assist you throughout your time in this space, which is dedicated entirely to children and families.



Dates: Open all year round:

- Spring holidays (April), summer holidays (July and August), All Saints' Day holidays: Monday to Saturday from 10.00 a.m. to noon and from 2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m., Sundays from 2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m.
- Winter holidays: Monday to Sunday from 2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m.
- During term time: Saturdays from 2.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. and open every day for organised groups by prior arrangement.



Various fun and educational activities are offered to children, for example:

- A variety of colouring pages on the theme of the apparitions and Saint Bernadette
- Making a personalised lantern for the Marian torchlight procession
- Making a personalised rosary with a short lesson on the rosary
- Story of the apparitions: the beautiful story of Saint Bernadette and the apparitions told in a fun way, with little characters to move around.
- Different games for discovering the message of Lourdes and the life of Saint Bernadette (board game, puzzles, Playmobil figures of the grotto, etc.)
- Children's procession to the garden of contemplation, opposite the Grotto.

A special area has been set up for toddlers (play mats, building blocks), and a changing table and microwave are available for families with babies. The chapel at the entrance allows those who wish to do so to conclude their visit with a moment of prayer.



Time required for groups:

Allow 45 minutes to 1 hour for each workshop led by a facilitator (making rosaries, lanterns, stories of the apparitions, etc.).



WEDNESDAYS IN JUNE



Dates: Wednesdays 3rd, 10th, 17th and 24th.



Times: between 10.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m.



What? On Wednesdays in June, the youth ministry offers a day of pilgrimage for groups of children and their chaperones, parishes, schools and families.

Three activities are available:

1- Mass at the Crypt (in French)

11 a.m.: preparation 11.30 a.m.: Mass (40 min)

2- The signs of Lourdes: a fun tour of the signs (Rock, Water, Light) (1.5 hours)

3- Praying the Rosary 3.00 p.m.: preparation, 3.30 p.m.: Rosary at the Grotto (in French)

SERVING THE SICK



EXPLORE FURTHER: DISCOVER BARTRÈS...

Take advantage of your pilgrimage to discover the village of Bartrès, near Lourdes, where Saint Bernadette once lived and worked.



Discover Bartrès, a charming little village nestled in the Bigorre countryside, with its evocative and historic sites linked to Bernadette Soubirous.

It was in this village that, from November 1845 to April 1846, Bernadette Soubirous, aged just ten months, was entrusted to Marie Lagües, who had recently lost her baby boy. In September 1857, at the age of 13, her former nanny needed help and asked her to return to look after her young children and tend to a few sheep. Bernadette then returned to her family in Lourdes in January 1858, just a few weeks before the first apparition of the Virgin Mary at the Grotto of Massabielle.

A pretty signposted path (5 km – 1 hour 15 minutes' walk) connects the Sanctuary of Lourdes to the village of Bartrès, where you can visit the sheepfold where Bernadette used to tend her flock, as well as the Church of Saint John the Baptist.



